REGENERATIVE AGRICULTURE FOR SUSTAINABLE PROFITABILITY

Three of the nation's top soil health practitioners – **Gabe Brown, Jay Fuhrer and Marlon Winger** - will convene in Idaho Falls on March 4, 2019, for the **ESWS Soil Health Conference: “Regenerative Agriculture for Sustainable Profitability.”**

Regenerative Agriculture describes a strategic approach for managing your farm/ranch soil resource for short- and long-term returns: improving the soil's biological, chemical and physical attributes in order to increase yields, nutrient capture, water retention/cycling, and resistance to disease/pests - while at the same time boosting economic returns through sustainable crop/forage/range production and quality. Gabe, Jay and Marlon will discuss practical, ecological and economic aspects of proactive soil management, diversifying crop and grazing regimens, reducing inputs, and integrative resource management.

▶ Who should attend? Everyone who recognizes their soil resource is the living foundation of sustainable crop and forage production and profitable farming/ranching. Content will be applicable to irrigated and dryland crops including traditional, transitional and organic, plus pasture, range and hay production systems of all sizes.
